North East-quarter of Section Four (4) in Township Ten north of Range Sixteen west in the District of Lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing one hundred and forty eight acres and fifty five hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Charles Bishop the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Charles Bishop and to his heirs and assigns forever.

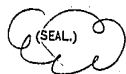
