Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress approved 21st May, 1862 "To secure Commodities to actual settlers on the public domain" and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of William M. White has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South half of the South East quarter, the North East quarter of the South East quarter and the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section six in Township eleven North, of Range eighteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General Newberry, that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said William M. White the tract of land above described to have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereto unto the said William M. White and to his heirs and assigns forever In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
