The United States of America, To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting; Whereas Edward J. Wilbur of Buffalo County, Nebraska has de-
posited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the
Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears
that full payment has been made by the said Edward J. Wilbur according
to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th day of April, 1820; en-
titled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands,
and the acts supplemental thereto, for

The East half of the North East quarter and the North half of the South East
quarter of Section eighteen in Township twelve North of Range fifteen West
of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing one hundred and
sixty acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the
General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been
purchased by the said Edward J. Wilbur. Now know ye, that the United States
of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the au-
thority of Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and grant-
ed, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Edward J. Wilbur
and to his heirs, the said tract above described; to have and to hold the
same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurte-
nances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging unto the said Edward
J. Wilbur and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof, I,
Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America, have caused
these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office
to be hereunto affixed. Witness under my hand, at the City of Washington,
the sixteenth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and ninety one, and of the Independence of the United States
the one hundred and sixteenth.
