BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

WHEREAS, there are federal funds available under Section 5311 of the Federal Transit Act and for the Nebraska Public Transportation Assistance Program, and

WHEREAS, the RYDE Transit-Community Action Partnership of Mid Nebraska desires to apply for said funds to provide public transport in (transit system's service area).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; the Buffalo County Board of Commissioners hereby instructs the RYDE Transport to apply for said funds.

Said funds are to be used for the RYDE Transit transportation operations in the FY 2023-2024 Application for Public Transportation Assistance.

Local Funding Amount Match for 2023-2024: \$86,900.00.
