79-458. School district; tract of land set off from district; petition; conditions; procedure; appeal

Effective: July 19, 2024

Currentness

(1) Any freeholder or freeholders, person in possession or constructive possession as vendee pursuant to a contract of sale of the fee, holder of a school land lease under section 72-232, or entrant upon government land who has not yet received a patent therefor may file a petition on or before June 1 for all other years with a board consisting of the county assessor, county clerk, and county treasurer, asking to have any tract or tracts of land described in the petition set off from an existing school district in which the land is situated and attached to a different school district which is contiguous to such tract or tracts of land if:

(a)(i) The school district in which the land is situated is a Class I, II, or III school district which has had an average daily membership in grades nine through twelve of less than sixty for the two consecutive school fiscal years immediately preceding the filing of the petition;

(ii) Such Class I, II, or III school district has voted pursuant to section 77-3444 to exceed the maximum levy established pursuant to subdivision (2)(a) of section 77-3442, which vote is effective for the school fiscal year in which the petition is filed or for the following school fiscal year;

(iii) The high school in such Class I, II, or III school district is within fifteen miles on a maintained public highway or maintained public road of another public high school; and

(iv) Neither school district is a member of a learning community; or

(b) Except as provided in subsection (7) of this section, the school district in which the land is situated, regardless of the class of school district, has approved a budget for the school fiscal year in which the petition is filed that will cause the combined levies for such school fiscal year, except levies for bonded indebtedness approved by the voters of such school district and levies for the refinancing of such bonded indebtedness, to exceed the greater of (i) one dollar and twenty cents per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation of property subject to the levy or (ii) the maximum levy authorized by a vote pursuant to section 77-3444.

For purposes of determining whether a tract of land is contiguous, all petitions currently being considered by the board shall be considered together as a whole.

(2) The petition shall state the reasons for the proposed change and shall show with reference to the land of each petitioner: (a) That (i) the land described in the petition is either owned by the petitioner or petitioners or that he, she, or they hold a school

land lease under section 72-232, are in possession or constructive possession as vendee under a contract of sale of the fee simple interest, or have made an entry on government land but have not yet received a patent therefor and (ii) such tract of land includes all such contiguous land owned or controlled by each petitioner; (b) that the conditions of subdivision (1)(a) or (1)(b) of this section have been met; and (c) that such petition is approved by a majority of the members of the school board of the district to which such land is sought to be attached.

(3) The petition shall be verified by the oath of each petitioner. Notice of the filing of the petition and of the hearing on such petition before the board constituted as prescribed in subsection (1) or (4) of this section shall be given at least ten days prior to the date of such hearing by one publication in a legal newspaper of general circulation in each district and by posting a notice on the outer door of the schoolhouse in each district affected thereby, and such notice shall designate the territory to be transferred. Following the filing of a petition pursuant to this section, such board shall hold a public hearing on the petition and shall approve or disapprove the petition on or before July 15 following the filing of the petition based on a determination of whether the petitioner has complied with all requirements of this section. If such board approves the petition, such board shall change the boundaries of the school districts so as to set off the land described in the petition and attach it to such district pursuant to the petition with an effective date of August 15 following the filing of the petition, which actions shall cause such transfer to be in effect for levies set for the year in which such transfer takes effect.

(4) Petitions requesting transfers of property across county lines shall be addressed jointly to the county clerks of the counties concerned, and the petitions shall be acted upon by the county assessors, county clerks, and county treasurers of the counties involved as one board, with the county clerk of the county from which the land is sought to be transferred acting as chairperson of the board.

(5) Appeals may be taken from the action of such board or, when such board fails to act on the petition, on or before August 1 following the filing of the petition, to the district court of the county in which the land is located on or before August 10 following the filing of the petition, in the same manner as appeals are now taken from the action of the county board in the allowance or disallowance of claims against the county. If an appeal is taken from the action of the board approving the petition or failing to act on the petition, the transfer shall occur effective August 15 following the filing of the petition, which actions shall cause such transfer to be in effect for levies set for the year in which such transfer takes effect, unless action by the district court prevents such transfer.

(6) This section does not apply to any school district located on an Indian reservation and substantially or totally financed by the federal government.

(7) For school districts that have approved a budget for school fiscal year 2007-08 that will cause the combined levies, except levies for bonded indebtedness approved by the voters of the school district and levies for the refinancing of such bonded indebtedness, to exceed the greater of (a) one dollar and twenty cents per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation of property subject to the levy or (b) the maximum levy authorized by a vote pursuant to section 77-3444, the school boards of such school districts may adopt a binding resolution stating that the combined levies, except levies for bonded indebtedness approved by the voters of the school district and levies for the refinancing of such bonded indebtedness, for school fiscal year 2008-09 shall not exceed the greater of (i) one dollar and twenty cents per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation of property subject to the levy or (ii) the maximum levy authorized by a vote pursuant to section 77-3444. On or before May 9, 2008, such binding resolutions shall be filed with the Auditor of Public Accounts and the county assessors, county clerks, and county treasurers for all counties in which the school district has territory. If such binding resolution is filed on or before May 9, 2008, land shall not be set off and attached to another district pursuant to subdivision (2)(b) of this section in 2008.

(8) Nothing in this section shall be construed to detach obligations for voter-approved bonds from any tract of land.

Per Nebraska Revised Statute 79-458, we are filing this freeholder's petition in Buffalo County, Nebraska, to transfer land from one school district to another.

We, Gary and Jolene Jones, the owners of 22180 Range Road, Shelton, NE 68876, present this petition to address a matter of great importance to us. We would like to request to change the tax/school district of this piece of property from the Shelton School Tax District to Ravenna School Tax District.

On January 27, 2026, we, Gary and Jolene Jones, purchased on auction the Southeast Quarter of 30-11-13, Buffalo County, Nebraska (22180 Range Road, Shelton, NE 68876). This auction transaction was finalized at loan and real estate closing on March 13, 2026. This 160-acre quarter is currently described as follows:

Although our 160-acre tract is split into two tax parcels, we are most concerned with the parcel that contains our home, which is parcel #300204000. We would like to transfer this parcel from the Shelton School Tax District: 10-0019 to Ravenna School Tax District: 10-0069. The parcel where we will reside (parcel: 300204000) is most important to us to get changed to the Ravenna

school tax district, however, if given the opportunity, we would transfer the other 80 A (parcel: 300118500) of the new purchase from Gibbon school district to Ravenna school district as well.

Our new residence is on parcel: 300204000, as described fully above, however this is currently in the Shelton School District. When looking at the school district map of the area that we are discussing you will see that this change would easily attach to the Ravenna district and would actually help to reduce the size of a Shelton Public School 'island' or "doughnut hole" that currently consists of this tract and two tracts in 29-11-13, Buffalo County, NE. Please see Attachment 2 for a portion of the school district map.

We currently have additional real estate in the Ravenna School Tax District, however the piece where we reside is what dictates who and what we get to vote for in annual elections. Our family is moving from our home (parcel number: 280026000) that is 3 miles North and 1 mile West of this new purchase at 22180 Range Road (parcel number: 300204000). Our two young children have always attended Ravenna Public Schools and will continue to do so. However, since they are 10 and 11 years old, we are still currently needing the assistance of the school for transportation, especially in the afternoon. Since they are not of legal driving age, the bus service is a huge help to our working & farming/ranching family. In order to have bus pickup/drop off, be able to vote for the school district representatives that make the decisions for our children's education, and to be able to vote for measures that affect the school our children attend, we would ask you to strongly consider our request. As current Ravenna School District members, we recently voted in favor of a school bond to remodel our Junior High and High School that passed and we would like to continue to do our part in paying for this and providing this for our children to experience in future years.

The parcel where our new home is located (parcel number: 300204000) would easily attach to the three parcels, 300120000, 300224050, and 300224000, all further described below, that are currently in the Ravenna school district and are just South of the parcel (across the road) that we are discussing. Please see map on Attachment 1.

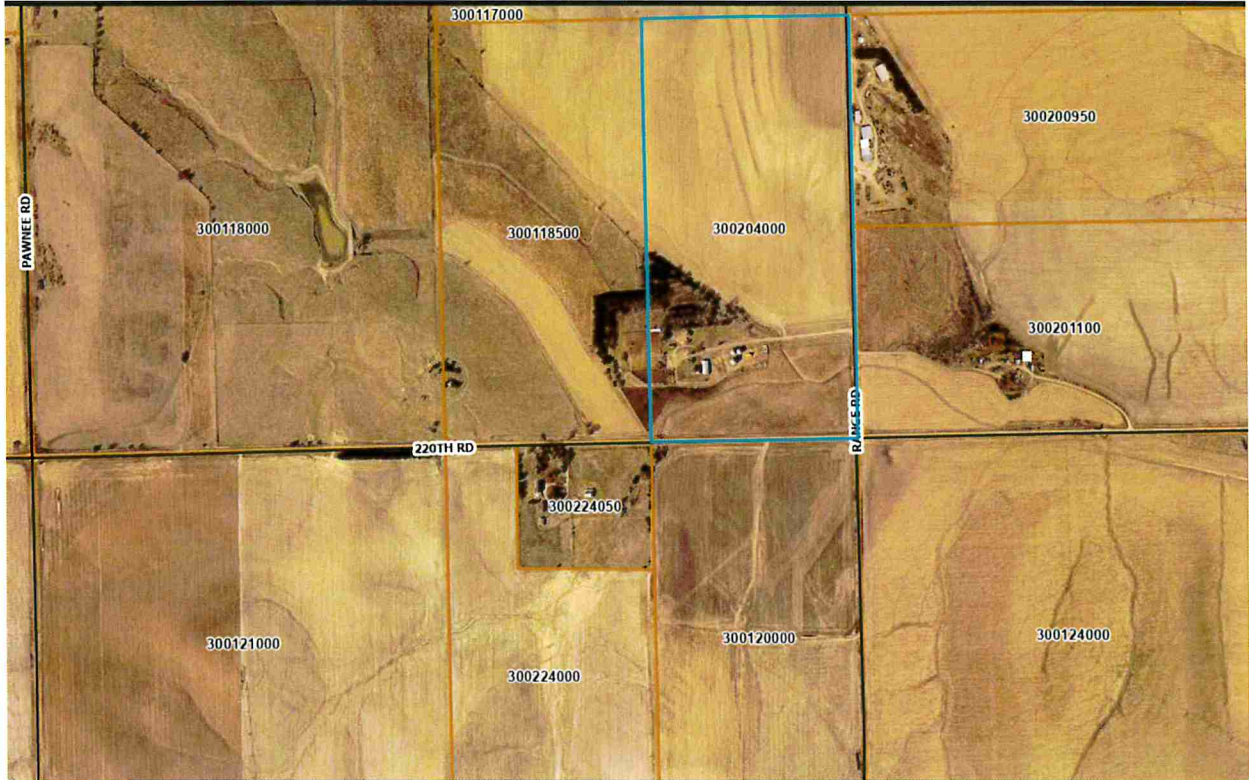

Subject: Freeholder petition

The Freeholder's Board has received the petition submitted requesting the transfer of land between school districts.

To ensure compliance with applicable law and to preserve the rights of all parties, the Freeholders Board will convene a public meeting to consider petition. The meeting will be conducted in two parts.

First, the Board will determine whether a sufficient petition, including all required statutory declarations, has been submitted. Second, if the petition is found to meet the minimum statutory requirements, the Board will proceed to consider the merits of the requested transfer.

As part of this process, you are hereby requested to show cause why the petition should be allowed to proceed to a hearing on the transfer issue. This request is made because, based on an initial review of the petition and publicly available tax levy information, it appears that the statutory minimum requirements for consideration may not be satisfied.

The applicable requirements are set forth in Nebraska Revised Statute § 79-458. Among other things, the statute requires:

1. That the school district to which the property is proposed to be transferred will accept the transfer;
2. That the land to be transferred is contiguous to the receiving district;  
**AND, Either (3) or (4);**
3. Certain conditions applicable to Class I, II, or III districts, including minimum enrollment thresholds, levy override approval under § 77-3444, proximity to another high school, and non-membership in a learning community;  
**OR**
4. That the school district from which the land is being transferred has approved a budget for the relevant fiscal year causing its combined levies (excluding specified bonded indebtedness) to exceed statutory thresholds, as defined in § 79-458.

As a preliminary matter, a valid petition must include declarations addressing these statutory requirements. Based on a review of publicly available levy histories obtained from the Assessor's Office, it appears that the "transferring" school district has not, in the relevant fiscal years, approved a budget resulting in combined levies exceeding \$1.20 per \$100 of taxable valuation, nor approved a levy override pursuant to § 77-3444.

If these facts are correct, the petition may fail to meet the statutory minimum requirements necessary for the Board to proceed to a hearing on the merits.

Further details regarding the date, time, and location of the meeting will be provided under separate notice.


