VEHICLE MAINTENANCE SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Vehicle Maintenance Services Agreement (“Agreement”) is made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 20, by and between: **Buffalo County, Nebraska**, a political subdivision of the State of Nebraska (“County”), and **Kearney Ag and Auto Repair** (“Contractor”).

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions under which Contractor shall provide routine vehicle maintenance services for:

- Buffalo County Sheriff’s Office fleet vehicles; and
- Buffalo County administrative vehicles.

2. TERM; RENEWAL

This Agreement shall commence on _____, 20__, and shall continue for a period of **three (3) years**, unless sooner terminated as provided herein. Upon expiration of the initial term, the Agreement **may be renewed for up to two (2) additional one (1) year terms**, upon:

- Mutual written agreement of the parties; and
- Approval by the Buffalo County Board of Commissioners.

Written notice of intent to renew shall be provided by the County at least **sixty (60) days prior** to the expiration of the then-current term.

3. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, equipment, and supervision necessary to perform vehicle maintenance services, including but not limited to:

- Complete lube service, including up to eight (8) quarts of oil and new oil filter
- Proper oil disposal
- Check and fill all under-hood fluids
- Check and fill front and rear differentials (and transfer case, if applicable)
- Inspect and lubricate chassis components
- Inspect windshield wipers
- Inspect air filter
- Check and adjust tire pressure
- Battery inspection
- Courtesy inspection for additional faults or maintenance needs
- Tire rotation (upon request)
- Tire tread depth measurement and reporting
- Interior vacuuming
- Cleaning of windshield

This list is not all-inclusive. Additional services may be performed upon written authorization by the County and Contractor.

4. SERVICE TIME GUARANTEE

Contractor shall provide priority service to County vehicles, particularly those assigned to the Buffalo County Sheriff's Office.

- Contractor guarantees a service turnaround time of **thirty (30) minutes or less** for routine maintenance services described herein.
- Sheriff's Office vehicles shall receive **first priority at all times**.
- If the Contractor is unable to meet the 30-minute service guarantee, Contractor shall immediately notify the County and document the reason and expected completion time.

Failure to consistently meet the service time guarantee may be considered a **material breach** of this Agreement.

5. SCHEDULING AND PRIORITY SERVICE

- Services may be performed on a walk-in or scheduled basis. The administrative vehicles will make an appointment.
- Contractor shall provide reasonable accommodation for urgent or emergency service requests.
- Sheriff's Office vehicles shall receive priority over all non-emergency services.

6. COMPENSATION

- Compensation shall be in accordance with a mutually agreed fee schedule.
- Contractor shall submit itemized invoices monthly unless otherwise approved by the County.
- The County shall pay approved claims within 45 days or receipt.

7. NON-APPROPRIATION (FUNDING OUT CLAUSE)

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, the County's obligations under this Agreement are subject to annual appropriation of funds by the Buffalo County Board of Commissioners.

In the event sufficient funds are not appropriated, the County may terminate this Agreement without penalty upon written notice to Contractor.

8. INSURANCE

Contractor shall maintain, at its own expense, insurance coverage as follows:

- Commercial General Liability
- Garage Liability Insurance
- Workers' Compensation Insurance in accordance with Nebraska law

Proof of insurance shall be provided to the County upon request.

9. INDEMNIFICATION

To the extent permitted by law, Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Buffalo County, its officers, officials, employees, and agents from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, and expenses arising out of or resulting from Contractor's performance under this Agreement, except to the extent caused by the negligence of the County.

10. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

Contractor shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and ordinances, including those of the State of Nebraska.

11. AUDIT AND RECORDS

Contractor shall maintain all records related to this Agreement for a period of at least **three (3) years** following final payment. The County or its authorized representatives shall have the right to audit such records upon reasonable notice.

12. TERMINATION

The County may terminate this Agreement:

- For convenience, upon **thirty (30) days written notice**; or
- For cause, immediately upon written notice for breach of any material term, including failure to meet service standards.

Contractor may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice to the County.

13. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

Contractor is an independent contractor and not an employee or agent of the County.

14. ASSIGNMENT

Contractor shall not assign or transfer any interest in this Agreement without the prior written consent of the County.

15. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Nebraska.

16. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement, including any exhibits, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations or agreements.

17. AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may be amended only by written agreement approved by both parties and, where required, by action of the Buffalo County Board of Commissioners.



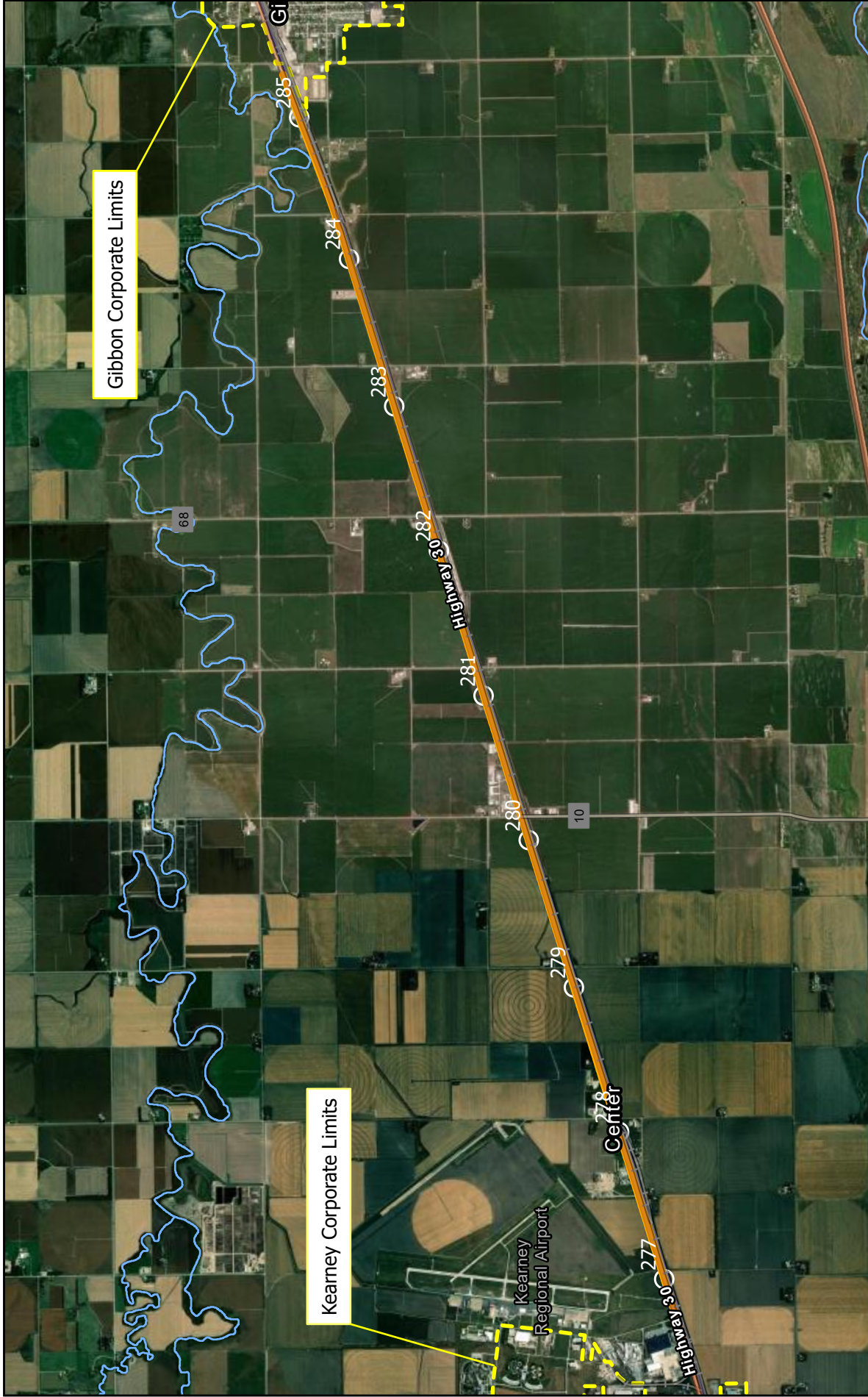

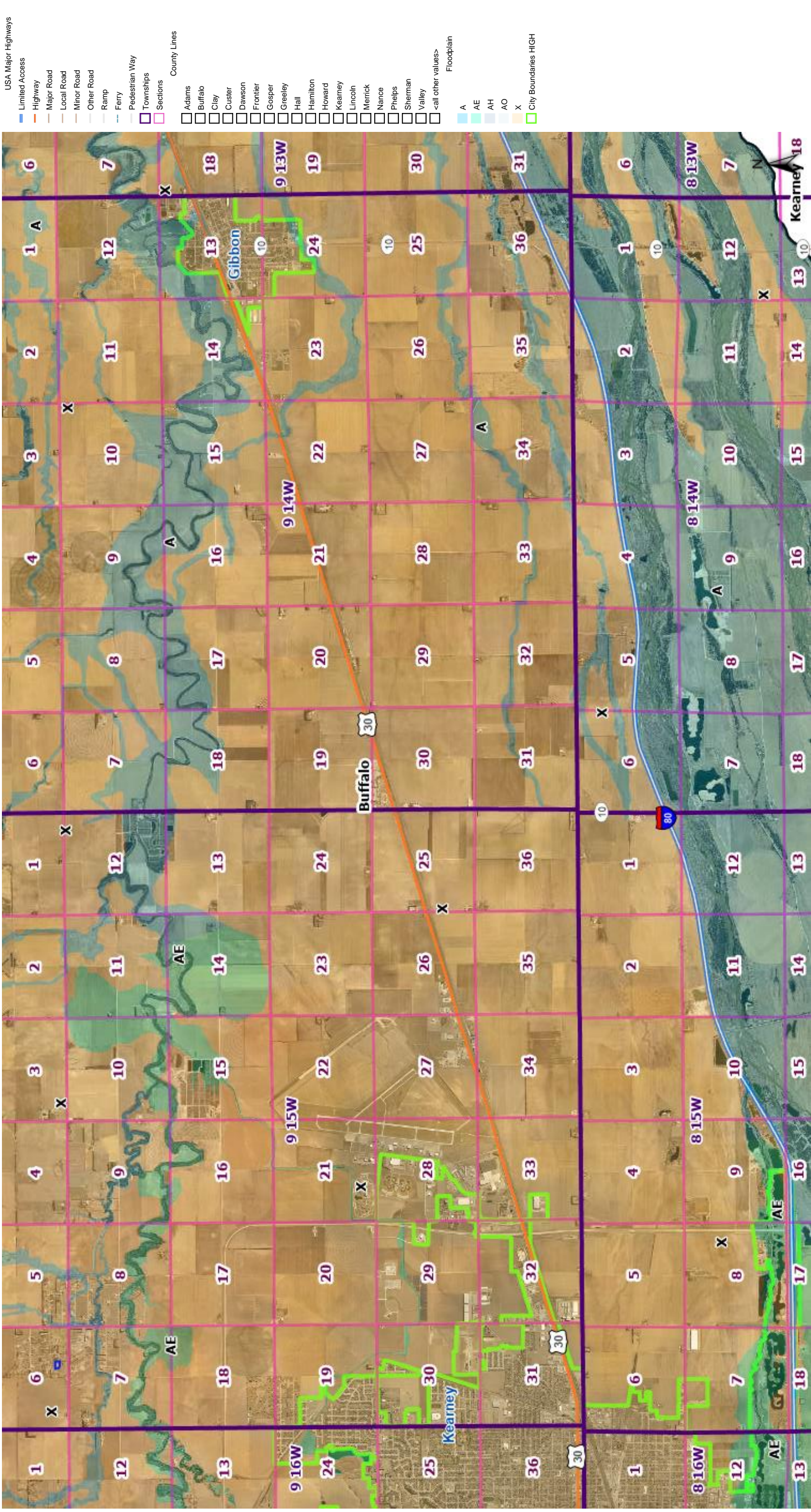
