TUESDAY, MAY 12, 2026**

The Buffalo County Board of Commissioners and the Buffalo County Board of Equalization met on Tuesday, May 12, 2026 at 9:00 A.M. and 9:30 A.M. Chairperson Morrow called the meeting to order and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. The following Board members responded to roll call: Ivan Klein, Myron Kouba, Ronald Loeffelholz, Daniel Lynch, Bill Maendele and Sherry Morrow. Absent: Timothy Higgins. A copy of the acknowledgment and receipt of notice and agenda by the Board of Commissioners is attached to these minutes. Public notice of this meeting was published/posted in the Kearney Hub, on the Buffalo County website, and the bulletin boards located outside the County Clerk's office and County Board Room on May 7, 2026. Chairperson Morrow announced that in accordance with Section 84-1412 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is available for review and posted at the back of the Board Room. Erickson for Administrative Subdivision to be known as “Erickson Second Administrative Subdivision”. This property is located in Part of Government Lot 14, of Section Seven (7), Township Nine (9) North, Range Sixteen (16) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Buffalo County, Nebraska. Licensed land surveyor Humphrey was present to review the application and answer questions. No one else addressed the Board and Chairperson Morrow closed the hearing at 9:37 A.M. Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Lynch to approve the Administrative Subdivision to be known as “Erickson Second Administrative Subdivision” with the following Resolution 2026-20. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Lynch, Klein, Kouba, Maendele and Morrow. Absent: Higgins. Motion declared carried.

### **RESOLUTION 2026-20**

WHEREAS, Mitch Humphrey, licensed land surveyor, on behalf of Timothy K. Erickson and Kathleen J. Erickson, hereinafter referred to as “applicant”, has filed for an Administrative Subdivision for “Erickson Second Administrative Subdivision”, with the Buffalo County Clerk and/or Zoning Administrator, and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Administrator forwarded this application to this Board, and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2026, this Board conducted a public hearing and finds:

1. The proposed “Erickson Second Administrative Subdivision” is in the Agricultural – Residential 2 (AGR – 2) Zoning District for Buffalo County, Nebraska.
2. The subject tract, presently owned Timothy K. Erickson and Kathleen J. Erickson is referred to as part of parcel 560385190 and is situated in part of Government Lot 13 and part of Government Lot 14, in Section Seven (7), Township Nine (9) North, Range Sixteen (16) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Buffalo County, Nebraska. The remnancy of the ownership owned by Timothy K. Erickson and Kathleen J. Erickson is approximately 74 acres.
3. The proposed plat for this subdivision fulfills Buffalo County’s Subdivision Resolution requirements for administrative subdivisions specifically allowed under Section 3.02, together with other provisions applicable, thereto.
4. Dove Hill Avenue is a county-maintained, open public road and the road abuts on the subdivision’s west side. The width of Dove Hill Avenue meets this county’s minimum width standards.
5. Title search paperwork has been provided to the Buffalo County Attorney’s Office and that office has cleared title as concerns Buffalo County’s interests based upon the title search documents delivered to that office by applicant.
6. This proposed administrative subdivision should be approved.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS in regular session with a quorum present, that the plat, “Erickson Second Administrative Subdivision”, an administrative subdivision located in Part of Government Lot 14, Section Seven (7), Township Nine (9) North, Range Sixteen (16) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Buffalo County, Nebraska, duly made out, acknowledged and certified, is hereby approved, accepted, ratified, and authorized to be filed and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds, Buffalo County, Nebraska

Moved by Maendele and seconded by Kouba to recess the regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners at 9:37 A.M. and reconvene as a Board of Equalization. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Maendele, Kouba, Klein, Loeffelholz, Lynch and Morrow. Absent: Higgins. Motion declared carried.

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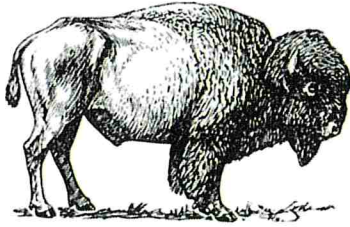

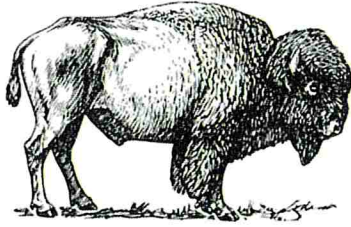

What is this about? The Nebraska Regional Interoperability Network (NRIN) provides a governance structure for NRIN. Counties and municipalities that have signed an Interlocal Agreement to elect an NRIN Governing Board to administer the monitoring, management, maintenance and sustainability of NRIN. This notice documents the process for nominating and electing candidates to fill Board positions that are due to expire 6/30/2026 on the NRIN Governance Board.

What is NRIN? NRIN is a regional and statewide wireless data communications sharing network that is owned by Nebraska's local governments. Its purpose is to connect Public-Safety Answering Points (PSAPs) or 9-1-1 centers. A nomination form is attached. Nominations must be submitted by the Chair of the member board. Once nominations have been submitted, ballots will be sent to each member public agency within the region. Only member public agencies can vote for candidates. Current NRIN Directors may be nominated for another term or nominations may be submitted for someone currently not on the NRIN Board.

What are the responsibilities of Board Members? Effectively participate in all Board functions. The Board shall govern, manage and coordinate NRIN to support public safety communications in Nebraska.
