Chairperson Klein opened the public hearing at 9:19 A.M. for the Buffalo County Zoning and Subdivision Regulations as part of the Buffalo County Comprehensive Plan, or the general plan for the improvement and development of the county outside of the jurisdiction of any city or village, as required per Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-174.06. Jason Wozniak a resident of Buffalo County spoke. No one else addressed the Board. Chairperson Klein closed the public hearing at 9:26 A.M. Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Kouba to table the Buffalo County Zoning and Subdivision Regulations as part of the Buffalo County Comprehensive Plan, or the general plan for the improvement and development of the county outside of the jurisdiction of any city or village, as required per Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-174.06 until December 10, 2024 for further review. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Kouba, Higgins, Lynch, Maendele, Morrow and Klein. Motion declared carried.

Zoning Administrator Daniels presented the Annual Report and Review of Special Use Permit Properties to the Board. After discussion it was moved by Maendele and seconded by Lynch to accept Annual Report and Review of Special Use Permit Properties. A copy will be on file with the County Clerk's office. BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

Chairperson Klein called the Board of Equalization to order in open session. County Assessor Roy Meusch and County Treasurer Brenda Rohrich were present.

On October 8, 2024 the County Board of Commissioners sitting as the County Board of Equalization approved the 2024-2025 Levy rates with resolution 2024-48. A request to combine two columns into one was received. Kearney Schools 7 columns "Capital 2024" and "Capital 2022" are now combined into one "Capital" column. No levy amounts have changed. Moved by Morrow and seconded by Lynch to accept the columniation change to the previously approved County levies with the following Resolution 2024-48A. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Lynch, Higgins, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Maendele and Klein. Motion declared carried.

Highway Superintendent Maul will review the bids and come back with recommendations at the next meeting on November 26, 2024.
