The Buffalo County Board of Supervisors met on Tuesday, July 27, 2010 at 9:00 A.M. Chairman Pierce called the meeting to order and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. Board of Classifications and Standard sent the Nebraska Department of Roads' One and Six Year highway Improvement Plan.
