

**BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
TUESDAY, JUNE 23, 2015  
9:00 A.M**

The Buffalo County Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, June 23, 2015 at 9:00 A.M. Chairman McMullen called the meeting to order and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. The following Board members responded to roll call: Francis Biehl, Joseph Brayton, Kent Greder, Ivan Klein, Sherry Morrow, Dennis Reiter and William McMullen. A copy of the acknowledgment and receipt of notice and agenda by the Board of Commissioners is attached to these minutes. Chairman McMullen announced that in accordance with Section 84-1412 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is available for review. Deputy County Clerk Leora Hofmann took all proceedings hereinafter shown; while the convened meeting was open to the public. County Attorney Shawn Eatherton and Deputy County Attorney Andrew Hoffmeister were present.

Chairman McMullen reviewed the City of Kearney notice of ordinance change about temporary firework stands and the State of Nebraska Department of Roads Federal Aid Urban Area Boundary Update that were received. Chairman McMullen called on each Board member present for committee reports and recommendations.

Moved by Brayton and seconded by Biehl to amend Resolution 2015-26 to include a complete legal for a lot vacated that will include quarter section, section, township and range. The legal description will be as follows: Lot Four (4), Block One (1) C.E.A. Second Subdivision, a subdivision being part of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4) of Section Seven (7), Township Nine (9), North, Range Sixteen (16), West of the Sixth P.M., Buffalo County, Nebraska. #### **RESOLUTION 2015-29**

WHEREAS, two Buffalo County departments have exceeded their approved budget for the 2014-2015 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, funds are needed to balance the budget for Buffalo County for the fiscal year 2014-2015 at the close of said fiscal year on June 30, 2015

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, to balance the budget for Buffalo County for the fiscal year 2014-2015 that \$25,000.00 be transferred to the County Court budget and \$1,000.00 be transferred to the Surveyors budget with the transfer to be made from the General Miscellaneous budget.

Buffalo County Juvenile Services Administrator Doug Kramer was present to discuss the adoption of a Juvenile Services Comprehensive Community 3 Year Plan. Buffalo County Community Partners Executive Director Denise Zweiner also addressed the Board and thanked the County for their involvement in serving youth. Moved by Brayton and seconded by Klein to adopt the Comprehensive Community Plan and to submit this plan to the Nebraska Crime Commission. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted “Aye”: Brayton, Klein, Biehl, Greder, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. None voted “Nay”. Motion declared carried.

Deputy County Attorney Hoffmeister discussed Highway Superintendent Ron Sklenar’s report that was filed regarding the petition to vacate a public road and recommended that the Board set the public hearing date. Moved by Klein and seconded by Brayton to approve the following Resolution 2015-30 to set a public hearing on the petition to vacate a public road known as “Buggy Road” or 310<sup>th</sup> Road, an east to west 3 rod road located in Section 26, Township 12 North, Range 15, West of the 6<sup>th</sup> p.m. between Imperial and Poole Roads in Buffalo County. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted “Aye”: Klein, Brayton, Biehl, Greder, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. None voted “Nay”. Motion declared carried.

#### **RESOLUTION 2015-30**

WHEREAS, a Petition to abandon or vacate a public road has been properly filed for the following public road:

“Buggy Road” or 310<sup>th</sup> Road, an east to west 3-rod road described in Buffalo County Commissioner Record Book 7, Page 560 located in Section 26, Township 12 North, Range 15, West of the 6th P.M. between Imperial and Poole Roads, in Buffalo County, Nebraska, described in more detail in a metes and bounds description that accompanied the Petition

And,

WHEREAS, the Buffalo County Highway Superintendent has made a study and has reported his recommendation to this Board; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to set this matter down for Public Hearing with notice to be given by: (1) publication of the proposed abandonment to be given by publication of this resolution for three consecutive weeks and (2) notice of this hearing also given

no less than two weeks in advance of the hearing to owners of land adjoining the road to be vacated or abandoned by registered or certified mail, and

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, this Board shall in the next meeting following the public hearing, or as soon thereafter as may be practicable, by resolution take action to vacate or abandon or refuse vacation or abandonment this road as in the judgment of the board the public good may require.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Buffalo County Board of Commissioners sets down July 28, 2015, at 10:00 o'clock, a.m. as the date and time of public hearing regarding vacation or abandonment of this road with hearing to be held in the Buffalo County Boardroom, Buffalo County Courthouse, Kearney, Nebraska.

Sheriff Neil Miller was present for the review and recommendation of the Nebraska Department of Correctional Service inmate housing contract. The State of Nebraska submitted an RFP (request for proposal) which was reviewed by County Attorney Shawn Eatherton. Moved by Klein and seconded by Brayton to authorize the Chairman's signature on the contract with the Nebraska Department of Correctional Services. The rate will be set at \$75.00 per day with Sheriff Miller's recommendation to house up to 10 inmates per day. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Klein, Brayton, Biehl, Greder, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. None voted "Nay". Motion declared carried.

Network Manager Cody Nelson presented the Information Technology April-June 2015 Quarterly Report. No action was necessary. Nelson also discussed the use of two Internet Service Providers for Buffalo County. The second provider will increase speed, improve resilience and serve as a backup in case the primary provider is down. Moved by Greder and seconded by Reiter to authorize the Chairman's signature on the USA Communications service agreement. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Greder, Reiter, Biehl, Brayton, Klein, Morrow and McMullen. None voted "Nay". Motion declared carried.

Moved by Greder and seconded by Klein to recess the regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners at 9:50 A.M. and reconvene as a Board of Equalization. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Greder, Klein, Biehl, Brayton, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. None voted "Nay". Motion declared carried.
