BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

The Buffalo County Board of Commissioners and the Buffalo County Board of Equalization met on Tuesday, September 25, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. and 9:30 A.M. Moved by Morrow and seconded by Klein to authorize Chairman McMullen to sign the Certificate of Cost Allocation Plan dealing with the countywide cost allocation plan prepared by the Sequoia Consulting Group. Upon roll call vote, the following Board

After review of the County Sheriff's reports for three Special Designated Liquor Licenses (SDL's), it was moved by Greder and seconded by Brayton to approve the Special Designated Liquor License applications filed by C & H Adventures LLC; DBA: Cedar Hills Vineyard & Gardens for events to be located at the Winery Tasting Room, 48970 375th Road, Ravenna, NE. Dates of events to be held are as follows: October 12, 13 and 14, 2018, October 19, 20 and 21, 2018 and October 26, 27, and 28, 2018. These special designated liquor licenses will allow the business to operate in the Tasting Room and sell other winery products because they lost their own winery building in a fire. Mark Gillming, Network Manager for the Buffalo County IT Department, presented his quarterly report to the Board.

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

Chairman McMullen called the Board of Equalization to order in open session. County Assessor Ethel Skinner, County Treasurer Jean Sidwell and Deputy County Attorney Andrew Hoffmeister were present.

Chairman McMullen opened the Public Hearing for the Motor Vehicle tax exemption application for Revival Revolution. The Board discussed the application with Treasurer Sidwell.
