The Buffalo County Board of Commissioners and the Buffalo County Board of Equalization met on Tuesday, January 22, 2019 at 9:00 A.M. and 9:45 A.M. Chairman McMullen called the meeting to order and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. Moved by Morrow and seconded by Loeffelholz to accept the County Treasurer Semi-Annual Report. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Loeffelholz, Higgins, Klein, Kouba, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Morrow and seconded by Klein to approve the release of pledged collateral for the Buffalo County Treasurer for \$205,000.00 at the Exchange Bank. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Klein, Higgins, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Morrow and seconded by Reiter to approve the addition of pledged collateral for the Buffalo County Treasurer for \$260,000.00 at the Exchange Bank. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Reiter, Higgins, Klein, Kouba, Loeffelholz and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Laura Robbins was present for the review of five Special Designated Liquor Licenses (SDL's) applications. After discussion and review of the County Sheriff's report, it was moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Klein to approve the Special Designated Liquor License applications filed by Mac's Creek Vineyards & Winery for wine and beer sampling/off sale events to be held at the Iain Nicolson Audubon Center at Rowe Sanctuary located at 44450 Elm Island Rd, Gibbon, NE. The events will be on March 2, March 9, March 16, March 23, and March 30, 2019. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Klein, Higgins, Kouba, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Emergency Manager Darrin Lewis was present to review the SCPETR Interlocal Agreements. Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Reiter to authorize Chairman McMullen to sign the South Central Region (PET) Memorandum of Understanding and the Interlocal Agreements for Cooperative Public Safety and the All Hazard Response Team with the following Resolution 2019-01. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Reiter, Higgins, Klein, Kouba, Morrow and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

### **RESOLUTION 2019-01**

WHEREAS the Counties of Adams, Buffalo, Clay, Dawson, Franklin, Frontier, Gosper, Hall, Hamilton, Harlan, Kearney, Lincoln, Nuckolls, Phelps, and Webster and the cities and villages within such counties desire to form a Planning, Exercise, and Training Region among the public safety agencies within such counties, and

WHEREAS, an Interlocal Government Agreement has been drafted that addresses issues as to creation, operation, and governance of entity described within the interlocal agreement as "South Central Planning, Exercise, and Training Regional" Group, a/k/a "SCPETR", and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that Buffalo County accepts the Interlocal Agreement between itself, the named counties and cities and/or villages therein, and this Board authorizes its Chairperson to sign such agreement on behalf of Buffalo County, to sign South Central Region Memorandum of Understanding presented with the Interlocal Agreement for Cooperative Public Safety and the Interlocal Agreement for the All Hazard Response Team and to do all necessary to carry out the provisions of such Interlocal agreements.

Moved by Reiter and seconded by Higgins to appoint the Buffalo County Emergency Management Director Darrin Lewis and the Emergency Management Deputy Robert Tubbs to the Emergency Management Regional group known as the South Central Region to fulfill all duties as required by the Regional group. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Reiter, Higgins, Klein, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Morrow and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

The 2018 Planning and Zoning Annual Report acceptance was tabled until the February 12, 2019 Board meeting.

Chairman McMullen reviewed the following correspondence. Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) will be sending out monthly project status updates. Invitations were received from the Kearney Area Chamber of Commerce for their 100<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting and the Buffalo County Economic Development Annual Meeting. Notice of updates and annual membership renewal form from Activate Buffalo County's worksite wellness program and a notice from the Nebraska Jail Standards Board confirming visit to conduct the annual inspection of the Buffalo County Jail facility. Chairman McMullen called on each Board member present for committee reports and recommendations.

Weed Superintendent Bret Stubbs was present to review the Annual State Reports. Moved by Higgins and seconded by Reiter to authorize Chairman McMullen to sign the reports as presented to be filed for the Weed District State Reports. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Higgins, Reiter, Klein, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Morrow and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Highway Superintendent John Maul was present for the following agenda items.

Moved by Klein and seconded by Loeffelholz to set a date of February 12, 2019 at 10:00 A.M. for the One and Six Road and Bridge Public Hearing. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Klein, Loeffelholz, Higgins, Kouba, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

The One and Six Year Road and Bridge Plans were reviewed by the Highway Superintendent John Maul and the Board of Commissioners.

Moved by Morrow and seconded by Higgins to recess the regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners at 9:56 A.M. and reconvene as a Board of Equalization. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Higgins, Klein, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.
