BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION
TUESDAY, APRIL 23, 2019**

The Buffalo County Board of Commissioners and the Buffalo County Board of Equalization met on Tuesday, April 23, 2019 at 9:00 A.M. and 9:45 A.M. Chairman McMullen called the meeting to order and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. The following Board members responded to roll call: Timothy Higgins, Ivan Klein, Myron Kouba, Ronald Loeffelholz, Sherry Morrow, Dennis Reiter and William McMullen. A copy of the acknowledgment and receipt of notice and agenda by the Board of Commissioners is attached to these minutes. Chairman McMullen announced that in accordance with Section 84-1412 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is available for review. County Clerk Janice Giffin took all proceedings hereinafter shown; while the convened meeting was open to the public. County Attorney Shawn Eatherton and Deputy County Attorney Andy Hoffmeister were present.

RESOLUTION 2019-11

WHEREAS, The Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 77-1901 through 77-1918 provides upon resolution by the County Board of Commissioners for foreclosure and sale of Real Estate Properties upon which Tax Sale Certificates have been placed and delinquent for three years, and

WHEREAS, the following Tax Sale Certificates have been placed on Real Estate Properties in Buffalo County, to wit: Numbers: 16187, 16194

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Buffalo County Board of Commissioners authorize the foreclosure and sale of the above referenced Tax Sale Certificates and request the County Attorney to proceed to such foreclosure and sale, in accordance with the laws of the State of Nebraska.

Sheriff Neil Miller was present to discuss the possible relocation of the office of the Emergency Manager from the Law Enforcement Center at 2025 Avenue A to the Emergency Operations Center at 1417 Central Avenue. No formal action was necessary and the Emergency Manager will now be located at the Emergency Operations Center.

Moved by Kouba and seconded by Klein to authorize Chairman McMullen to sign the Business Associate Agreement Amendment with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Kouba, Klein, Higgins, Loeffelholz, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

After discussion and review of the County Sheriff's report with Travis Evans from Sozo American Cuisine, LLC, it was moved by Klein and seconded by Higgins to approve the Special Designated Liquor License application filed for an event to be held June 1, 2019 at 14505 Gibbon Road, Gibbon, NE. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Klein, Higgins, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Chairman McMullen reviewed the following correspondence. Central Nebraska Drug Court sent an invitation to the 32nd Drug Court Graduation Ceremony. The Nebraska Department of Transportation sent a Local Project Monthly Status Update for the Poole South Project. City of Kearney sent the Agenda for the Planning Commission meeting, and Buffalo County Community Health Partners sent a Thank you for the County's investment and membership in Activate Buffalo County wellness program. Chairman McMullen called on each Board member present for committee reports and recommendations.

Chairman McMullen opened the Public Hearing for the Buffalo County 2018-2019 Budget Amendment at 9:30 A.M. The purpose of this amendment was necessary to create a budgetary fund known as the Disaster Fund to track accounting expenses and receipts related to the disaster recovery and relief in Buffalo County. No one addressed the Board and the public hearing was closed at 9:31 A.M.

Moved by Morrow and seconded by Reiter to approve the following Resolution 2019-12 creating the Disaster Fund budget item as presented. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Reiter, Higgins, Klein, Kouba, Loeffelholz and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

RESOLUTION 2019-12

WHEREAS, Buffalo County anticipates receiving funds for disaster relief and these funds need to be accounted for separate from other funds,

WHEREAS, it is necessary and proper that Buffalo County create a budgetary fund for the accounting of the receipts and the expenditures of said fund. Fund #2575 was assigned by the State Auditor's Office for the "Disaster Fund."

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT Buffalo County create a fund to be known as "Disaster Fund", numbered 2575 on Buffalo County's accounting and budgeting systems.

Moved by Morrow and seconded by Higgins to approve the amendment of the 2018-2019 Buffalo County budget, there will be no change to the property tax requirement for fiscal year 2018-2019. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Higgins, Klein, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Morrow and seconded by Higgins to approve the following transfer of County funds for the purpose of creating the Disaster Fund, as a loan to be paid back as funds become available. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Higgins, Klein, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

Chairman McMullen called the Board of Equalization to order in open session. County Assessor Ethel Skinner and County Treasurer Jean Sidwell were present.

Chairman McMullen opened the public hearing for the Protest of Property Taxations. City of Kearney Attorney Michael J. Tye was present on behalf of the City of Kearney Airport Land parcel 620143540, and Larry E. Butler Attorney was present on behalf of the Buffalo County Agricultural Association parcel 600009000. During the meeting County Assessor Skinner stated the taxations should not happen and withdrew the intent to tax the parcels in question. Chairman McMullen closed the hearing at 9:56 A.M.

Moved by Klein seconded by Loeffelholz that Buffalo County Board of Equalization Confesses Judgment in Tax Equalization & Review Commission Case #18-R0188 in appeal concerning Grand West, LLC, Appellant, and Buffalo County, Appellee, for property identified as tax parcel #580143502 and that the Buffalo County Attorney's Office be, and hereby is, authorized to confess judgment on behalf of this Board, that for tax year 2018 this property had an assessed valuation of \$63,910. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Klein, Loeffelholz, Higgins, Kouba, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Higgins and seconded by Klein to approve the Motor Vehicle Tax Exemption as indicated on the application by County Treasurer for The Salvation Army on a 2019 Chevrolet Traverse.
