**WHEREAS**, The Revised Statutes of Nebraska, Sec. 77-1809 and 77-1918, provides that upon the direction of the County Board of Commissioners, for the County Treasurer to issue Tax Sale Certificates in the name of the County, and

**WHEREAS**, the following list of legal descriptions have either delinquent taxes for the years 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, OR 2017 and have been offered for sale at Public Sale, and have remained unsold for want of bidders,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Buffalo County Board directs the County Treasurer of Buffalo County, to place Tax Sale Certificates on all delinquent taxes and special assessments for 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and to maintain such Certificates in her custody, and to purchase all subsequent taxes thereon as the same may become delinquent.

**Whereas:** Buffalo County and Alfred Benesch & Company wish to enter into a Professional Services Agreement to provide NEPA services for the Federal-aid project.

**Be It Resolved:** by the Board of Commissioners of Buffalo County that: William McMullen, Chair of the Buffalo County Board of Commissioners, is hereby authorized to sign the attached NEPA services agreement between Buffalo County, Nebraska and Alfred Benesch & Company.

The Board discussed hiring an engineering firm to do a study on 30<sup>th</sup>, 46<sup>th</sup>, and 62<sup>nd</sup> Avenues south of Turkey Creek concerning flooding and road issues. Maps of the area showing the floodplain were provided to the Board by Floodplain Administrator Jason Wozniak. Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Morrow to hire an engineering firm to do a study on 30<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 46<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 62<sup>nd</sup> Avenue concerning flooding and road issues. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Morrow, Higgins, Kouba, Reiter and McMullen. Absent: Klein. Motion declared carried.

The Board discussed closing a portion of 30<sup>th</sup> Avenue due to safety concerns and no action was taken at this time.

Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Reiter to allow the Highway Department to work five (5) ten (10) hour days on a month-to-month basis weather permitting to help repair flood damaged county roads and bridges. Highway Superintendent John Maul reported on future areas in the County that need addressed from the recent declared disaster in Buffalo County and the current status of the Budget. Amending the Buffalo County 2018-2019 Budget will be addressed again as more information is gathered on all the damage costs to make the necessary repairs.

Kearney Visitors Bureau Executive Director Roger Jasnoch was present to update the Board and presented the following reports for the current 2018-2019 fiscal year: Visitors Board Promotion Committee listing, Charts of Visitors Promotion Committee and Visitors Bureau Lodging Tax and Occupation Tax, Visitor Promotion Actual Budget, Projects currently receiving Community Grant funds, Sports and Special Events Sales Budget and Lodging Tax Comparison with other Counties. Moved by Higgins and seconded by Reiter to accept the Kearney Visitors Bureau reports as presented. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Higgins, Reiter, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Morrow and McMullen. Absent: Klein. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Higgins to recess the regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners at 9:59 A.M. and reconvene as a Board of Equalization. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Higgins, Kouba, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. Absent: Klein. Motion declared carried.

## **BOARD OF EQUALIZATION**

Chairman McMullen called the Board of Equalization to order in open session. County Assessor Ethel Skinner and County Treasurer Jean Sidwell were present.

After convening of the Buffalo County Board of Equalization the Board considered the protest of the City of Kearney against the intent to tax parcels # 520164000, 520165000 and 520040000 that it received earlier this year from the County Assessor. Deputy County Attorney Hoffmeister was present to review the protest. Michael J. Tye, City Attorney appeared on behalf of the City of Kearney and provided the Board with testimony and written materials. He informed the Board that the parcels in question are used by the city as well fields to supply the City of Kearney with water. Currently a tenant is allowed to graze cattle on the parcels as an incidental use of the properties. He noted that in a recently issued ruling of the Nebraska Supreme Court, the Court ruled that the grazing use was incidental to the government's predominate use of the wellfields. Thereafter the Court held the wellfield in question before it was exempt from taxation. That case practically had the same factual situation of the city wellfield and the parcels in question. The same ruling would apply to the City of Kearney's situation regarding its wellfields. No other parties spoke in favor or against the issue. Chairman McMullen closed the hearing at 10:09 A.M. Moved by Higgins and seconded by Loeffelholz that because predominant government use and purposes are being made of the following parcels 520164000, 520165000 and 520040000, the parcels in question together with any tenant's use of the same should be exempted from real estate taxation for tax year 2019. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Higgins, Loeffelholz, Kouba, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. Absent: Klein. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Higgins to approve the Motor Vehicle Tax Exemption as indicated on the application by County Treasurer for Midwest District of the EFCA on a 2017 Subaru Outback and a 2002 Doolittle enclosed trailer. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Higgins, Kouba, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. Absent: Klein. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Reiter and seconded by Higgins to approve the Motor Vehicle Tax Exemption as indicated on the application by County Treasurer for RYDE Transit-Community Action Partnership of Mid-Nebraska on two 2017 Ford Cutaways.
