Moved by Morrow and seconded by Klein to accept the Buffalo County Treasurer February 2020 Fund Balance Report. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Klein, Higgins, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Commissioner Kouba reported on the Activate Buffalo County's Worksite Wellness membership through the Buffalo County Community Partners. Moved by Kouba and seconded by Klein to continue the membership with the Worksite Wellness Program through the Buffalo County Community Partners. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Kouba, Klein, Higgins, Loeffelholz, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Kouba and seconded by Morrow to authorize Bob Charlesworth, Health Insurance Consultant with Charlesworth Consulting LLC to finalize an agreement to conduct health screening for Buffalo County employees. Moved by Morrow and seconded by Klein to set a bid date of April 14, 2020 at 10:30 A.M. for Site Work and Concrete Construction for the Highway Department Salt Building. Facilities Director Steve Gaasch was present for the proposal of the Buffalo County Facilities Building Addition located at the Buffalo County Courthouse. Zoning Administrator Dennise Daniels and Jason Wozniak were present for the following Zoning agenda item.

Chairman McMullen opened the public hearing at 9:18 A.M. for the proposed zoning map amendment filed by Thomas Baxter, on behalf of Jared Axmann Trucking, Inc. This Zoning Map Amendment is a request for property described as a tract in NE1/4 of the NW1/4 and Government Lot 1 North of Railroad located in Section 30, Township 9 North, Range 14 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Buffalo County, Nebraska. Asking for property to be rezoned from AG-Agricultural to I-Industrial. Jason Wozniak, Thomas Baxter and Jared Axmann reviewed the application. No one else addressed the Board and Chairman McMullen closed the public hearing at 9:24 A.M. Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Klein to approve the Zoning Map Amendment with the following Resolution 2020-09. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Klein, Higgins, Kouba, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

#### **RESOLUTION 2020-09**

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2020, Thomas H. Baxter, on behalf of Jared Axmann Trucking, Inc., has applied for a Zoning Map Amendment with the Buffalo County Zoning Administrator, requesting that the following real estate property, hereinafter referred to as the "subject property", to wit:

A tract of land being part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE1/4 NW ¼) and part of Government Lot One (1), located in Section Thirty (30), Township Nine (9) North, Range Fourteen (14) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Buffalo County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows: Referring to the Northwest Corner of Government Lot 1 in Section 30, and assuming the West Line of Government Lot 1 as bearing S 00°09'34" W and all bearings contained herein are relative thereto; thence S 00°09'34" W and on the West line of said Government Lot 1, a distance of 372.85 feet; thence S 89°29'20" E and parallel with the North line of said Government Lot 1 a distance of 1,102.02 feet to the actual place of beginning; thence continuing S 89°29'20" E and parallel with the North Line of said Government Lot 1, a distance of 150.18 feet, thence N 00°09'34" E and parallel with the West line of said Government Lot 1, a distance of 96.91 feet; thence S 89°29'20" E and parallel with the North line of said Government Lot 1, a distance of 373.17 feet; then S 04°30' E a distance of 11.73 feet to a point being N 04°30' W a distance of 313.5 feet from the North line of the Union Pacific Railroad Company's Right-of-Way, thence S 89°05'44" E a distance of 323.0 feet to a point being N 04°30' W a distance of 214.5 feet from the North line of the Union Pacific Railroad Company's Right-of-Way; thence N 04°30' W a distance of 290.95 feet to a point on the North line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 30, said point also being westerly a distance of 670.23 feet from the Northeast Corner of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 30; thence N 89°29'20" W and on the North line of said Northwest Quarter a

distance of 653.67 feet to the Northwest Corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 30, said point also being the Northeast corner of Government Lot 1 in said Section 30; thence N 89°29'20" W and on the North line of said Government Lot 1 a distance of 171.08 feet; thence S 00°09'34" W and parallel with the West line of said Government Lot 1, a distance of 372.84 feet to the place of beginning.

be changed from the Agricultural (AG) District to the Industrial (I) District. Property is in the name Jared E. Axmann.

WHEREAS, this is solely a zoning map amendment request and the subject property would or could have other land use regulations that would apply to it above and beyond the zoning map amendment sought at this meeting, and

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2020, the Buffalo County Planning and Zoning Commission following public hearing with notice as required recommended approval of such proposed change in zoning on a 8-0 vote with none absent and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020, this Board conducted a public hearing and considered this Zoning Map Amendment, the minutes of the Planning and Zoning Commission considering this amendment, Buffalo County Zoning Regulations, and Comprehensive Plan, and finds:

- a. That such change in zoning designation would have minimal adverse effect on surrounding properties.
- b. That the intended use of the Industrial District is consistent with property use in the surrounding area.
- c. This amendment is consistent with the growth and development of Buffalo County and the overall Comprehensive Plan adopted by Buffalo County, Nebraska, and
- d. The subject property is situated close to already existing public improvements, such as sufficient utilities so that the map amendment with its attendant changes in uses will not cause additional public costs to function effectively.

WHEREAS, no protest(s) against such amendment have been filed with the Buffalo County Clerk within seven days of conclusion of public hearing of such Commission as allowed under Section 11.4, and

WHEREAS, the votes in favor of adoption of this resolution need only be by majority of members to this Board of Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that application for zoning map amendment to change the subject property from the Agricultural (AG) District to Industrial (I) District is approved, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be filed in the Register of Deed's office against subject property and any parcel situated partially or entirely within such legal description, and that the County Clerk shall make amendment to Buffalo County Zoning District Map originally adopted on or about September 10, 2002.

**RESOLUTION 2020-10**

WHEREAS, Buffalo County strives to maintain our standards of excellent service to the public we serve, and

WHEREAS, to maintain our standard of service we must take reasonable efforts to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 exposure and infection towards our employees and the public, and

WHEREAS, we are unaware of the necessary duration of this risk, and

WHEREAS, we are remaining in contact with federal, state, and local officials to monitor ongoing needs, and

WHEREAS, we recognize our efforts to plan for potential impacts may need to be modified with little or no notice, and

WHEREAS, we recognize that our efforts may be superseded by federal, state, or local edict, court order, administrative order, or other legal requirements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that temporary modifications to employment policies and procedures are hereby authorized as presented to the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these policies may be further modified without Board action if modification becomes legally necessary. That the County Attorney's office is requested to monitor and modify these policies as required after appropriate consultation with relevant authorities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County may limit public access to facilities with little or no notice to the public. That this may include reduction or elimination in services available or in service hours.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County would like to encourage all citizens to limit unnecessary visits to public facilities and to encourage all citizens to conduct official government business by mail, phone, or online when practicably possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all elected officials are empowered to make reasonable and necessary modifications to operations without want of Board action. Further, that the Board Administrator or her designee are empowered to make all reasonable and necessary modifications to operations without want of Board action unless otherwise required by law.

Deputy County Attorney Kari Fisk reviewed the policies for the County to maintain standards of services to the public and efforts to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 exposure and infection towards employees and the public. Moved by Higgins and seconded by Kouba to approve the closure of public access to the courthouse with the following Resolution 2020-11. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Higgins, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Morrow, Reiter and Klein. Absent: McMullen. Motion declared carried.

**RESOLUTION 2020-11**

WHEREAS, Buffalo County strives to maintain our standards of excellent service to the public we serve, and

WHEREAS, to maintain our standard of service we must make reasonable efforts to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 exposure and infection towards our employees and the public, and

WHEREAS, we are unaware of the necessary duration of this risk, and

WHEREAS, we are remaining in contact with federal, state, and local officials to monitor ongoing needs, and

WHEREAS, we recognize our efforts to plan for potential impacts may need to be modified with little or no notice, and

WHEREAS, we recognize that our efforts may be superseded by federal, state, or local edict, court order, administrative order, or other legal requirements, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to make all reasonable efforts to protect the safety and wellbeing of our staff, to ensure that County employees do not leave employment during times of uncertainty, to avoid the spread of illness to other employees, for staff morale, and for other legitimate reasons.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of citizens requiring access to critical services that their exposure is minimized.

WHEREAS, the County has opportunities for citizens to conduct most County business via phone, US Mail, or online.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, that effective 5pm, March 18<sup>th</sup> and continuing until further notice the Courthouse and all other County operated buildings are closed to the general public and are open to employees only.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that so long as the Courts remain open for normal business access will be permitted to the public only to the Justice Center section of the Courthouse through its primary entrance. That, should the Court's closed access will cease. That any days the Court is not holding hearings, building access may be restricted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that citizens are directed to conduct business via mail, online, or by phone.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the limited functions of County Government which cannot be accomplished via mail, online, or by phone, such as marriage license issuance, may be conducted by advanced appointment only. No walk-in services will be provided. Citizens are required to call the appropriate offices to schedule an advanced appointment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that officials should take steps to support employee health including schedule modifications, work-from-home options, and temporary reductions in density and employee proximity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that officials may continue to pay employees for their hours either actually worked or regularly scheduled if the official determines it is in their best interest to modify the hours worked at their normal worksite.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Board sends their sincere thanks and support to their dedicated employees.

Moved by Morrow and seconded by Reiter to approve the Local Emergency Declaration that will be released to the public and will be on file with the County Clerk. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Reiter, Higgins, Kouba, Loeffelholz and Klein. Absent: McMullen. Motion declared carried.

# Recent Funding


- County is SELF-FUNDING the Group Health/Rx program – since 2012.
- 7/1/2016 Inception: County experienced a 5.35% Funding INCREASE
- 7/1/2017 Inception: County implemented a 5% DECREASE.
- 7/1/2018 Inception: County adopted a 10% DECREASE and an INCREASE to Dependent funding to \$350/month
- 7/1/2019 Inception: County took a 5% INCREASE due to experience trend and Rx cost increase and modified Dependent funding to \$400 per month.
- 7/1/2020 Inception: Anticipate a 7% INCREASE due to experience development. National trend is 4.5% for Medical and 9%-11% for Prescription Drugs (specialty drugs mostly).
  - The County's utilization in Generics actually rose from 84% to 88% of all dispensed Rx! Excellent.
  - Will have Renewal information to the Board in mid-May.

# HOW FUNDING WORKS

- Claims Cost update:
  - Rates are dictated heavily by the COUNTY'S CLAIMS EXPERIENCE
  - Have protection for claims above \$75,000 per Individual per Year – currently have four (4) individuals with claims in excess of this amount.
  - All claims under this are PAID BY THE COUNTY – Administered by BCBSNE.
  - County reserves are important to maintain and some excess amounts can be used to help offset future rates for all participants
- Experience has historically been positive, but law of averages suggest about one out of every 4-5 years, a group will experience a greater than expected claim payment period – this may be that year.
- County has strong reserves to help offset such swings in funding for one year.


# SNAPSHOT OF PAID CLAIMS THIS POLICY PERIOD


## Buffalo County, NE Health Benefit Plan 7/2017 thru 2/2020

# Health Screenings & H.R.A.


- **USED HY-VEE AS THE NEW SCREENING VENDOR – SAVED MONEY AND NOW HAVE ACCESS TO OTHER VOLUNTARY WELLNESS OPPORTUNITIES.**
- Renewal services from them is anticipated, but they have currently suspended on Wellness Screenings.
- County may have to make a decision to WAIVE the participation requirement in the wellness screenings and Health Risk Assessment where a non-participant would normally be charged \$20/Month (\$10 Per Pay for 24 pay periods).
- May still offer screening mid-year in order to allow members to “know their numbers”, and also allow members that chose to submit an Alternative Means Screening (AMS) form with bloodwork professionally collected through their own healthcare provider.
- REMINDER - BOTH the Screening and Health Risk Assessment historically must be completed and submitted by the end of May in order to meet the payroll deadlines for the County, so this may be the year to waive such requirements.

# Employee Assistance Plan

- RFP has been developed and issued by the County
- Proposals due at the County on April 24, 2020 (may need to check date)
- Benefits anticipated to include:
  - Six (6) session for employee and family members
  - Comprehensive on-line resources
  - Family and personal referrals (child care, elderly care, etc.)
  - Legal referrals
  - Financial information, budgeting, etc.
  - Supervisor and Management tools to help create a positive working environment
  - Mobile apps for services
  - Health plan coordination
- Goal was to focus on more personal visits as well as resources for Emergency Personnel.
