Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Higgins to recess the regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners at 9:35 A.M. and reconvene as a Board of Equalization. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Higgins, Kouba, Lynch, Maendele, Morrow and Klein. Motion declared carried.

### BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

Chairman Klein called the Board of Equalization to order in open session. County Assessor Ethel Skinner was present.

Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Morrow to rescind the decision on the permissive exemption public hearing held on March 8, 2022 for CHI Health-Good Samaritan on parcel 601995000. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Morrow, Higgins, Kouba, Lynch, Maendele and Klein. Motion declared carried.

Assessor Skinner clarified that the parcel number previously considered included more than the building used as a daycare facility and the immediate parking lot surrounding the facility located on the entire parcel owned by CHI Health-Good Samaritan. The recommendation from Assessor Skinner was that 18 percent of the land value and the facility should be taxed because it no longer met the tax exempt criteria. Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Kouba to deny exemption on 18 percent of the total land value and the building of the parcel 601995000 for CHI Health-Good Samaritan. The taxable portion will be \$506,720 and the rest of the parcel will remain tax exempt. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Kouba, Higgins, Lynch, Maendele, Morrow and Klein. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Lynch and seconded by Higgins to approve the permissive exemption waiver request for the Nebraska Art Museum Collection and authorize Assessor Skinner to consider the Permission Exemption. A public hearing will be held at the next Board meeting on April 12, 2022. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Lynch, Higgins, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Maendele, Morrow and Klein. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Maendele and seconded by Kouba to adjourn the Board of Equalization and return to the regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners at 9:48 A.M. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Maendele, Kouba, Higgins, Loeffelholz, Lynch, Morrow and Klein. Motion declared carried.
