To the extent not paid from other sources, the funds for repayment of the bonds will come from an ad valorem tax on all the taxable property in the Village. A "No" Vote: If a majority of the votes cast upon such questions shall be against issuing bonds, the Village shall not issue bonds to finance the construction of a swimming pool and related improvements. In such event, the swimming pool will not be constructed unless funds can be obtained from other sources and no ad valorem tax would be imposed on all the taxable property in the Village to pay for costs to construct a swimming pool.
