

# Notice of General Election

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November 2024 at the polling places in the election precincts of Buffalo County, Nebraska; a General Election will be held. You can find your polling location by using the Nebraska Voter Check website at: <https://www.votercheck.necvr.ne.gov/VoterView>. The polls will open at 8 a.m. CST and close at 8 p.m. CST. Said election will be for electing candidates to various offices and for such issues as stated. Some races will not appear on your General Election ballot as the candidates are elected by specific subdivisions, districts or wards.

The Secretary of State will publish a true copy of the title and text of any amendment or referendums once a week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election.

Voters MUST present an acceptable form of photo ID before casting a ballot in every primary, general & special election. Acceptable forms of photo ID MUST have your name & photo. A list of acceptable forms of photo ID can be found at: <https://sos.nebraska.gov/elections/voter-id>.
