Homestead Certificate No 5506 } these presents shall come, Creating:  
Application 8884 } Whereas there has been deposited in the  
General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register  
of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that  
pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20<sup>th</sup> May 1862. To secure  
Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain and the acts  
supplemental thereto the claim of James Anderson has been established  
and duly consummated, in conformity to law for the North East  
quarter of section three in township eight north of range  
fifteen west of the sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing  
one hundred and sixty acres and forty-five hundredths of an acre  
according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land returned  
to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General. Now know  
Ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the  
said James Anderson the tract of land above described to have  
and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances  
thereof unto the said James Anderson and to his heirs  
and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Grover Cleveland President of the  
United States of America have caused these letters to be made  
Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed  
Given under my hand at the City of Washington the ninth  
day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and eighty-eight and of the Independence of the United States  
the one hundred and twelfth.
