Whereas, there have been deposited in the General Land Office, of the United State, a Certificate of the Register of the Land office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of William Albrecht has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the North Half of the Northeast Quarter and the North Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section, Twelve, in Township Eleven, North of Range Eighteen, West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in Nebraska, containing One Hundred and Sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office, by the Surveyor General.

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States, unto the said William Albrecht, the tract of Land above described; To have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said William Albrecht, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
