North West quarter of the South West quarter, the South half of the South West quarter and the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Twenty in Township Eleven North of Range Sixteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said John King the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said John King and to his heirs and assigns forever.
