Beaver has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the North half of the North West quarter of Section nineteen in Township twelve North of Range seventeen West and the East half of the North East quarter of Section twenty four in Township twelve North of Range eighteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General :

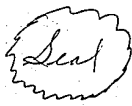
