Whereas James H. Bookers of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that Full Payment has been made by the said James H. Bookers according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act Making further provision for the Sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto for the North West Quarter of Section Eleven in Township Twelve North of Range Sixteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing One hundred and fifty acres according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said James H. Bookers.

Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said James H. Bookers and to his heirs the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereto belonging unto the said James H. Bookers and to his heirs and assigns forever.
