To all to whom these presents shall come greeting.
Certificate No. 1408. Whereas George A. Bailey of Buffalo County, Nebraska, has deposited in the general land office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said George A. Bailey, according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 26th of April 1820, entitled "the act vending for that provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for the lots numbered seven, eight, and nine of section Ten, in Township Eight, north of range seventeen west of the sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing one hundred and fifteen acres and ninety five hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said George A. Bailey. Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said George A. Bailey and to his heirs, the said tract above described, to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging unto the said George A. Bailey and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Charles A. Arthur, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed, Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the tenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and sixth.
