The United States of America, To all to whom
these presents shall come, greeting: Whereas, In
pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March
3, 1853, entitled "An Act in addition to certain
Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers
and Soldiers who have been engaged in
the Military Service of the United States, there
has been deposited in the General Land Office
Warrant No. 78848 for 160 acres, in favor
of Sally Derwin, Formerly widow of David
Bogert, Private Captain Dyckman's company
New York Militia. War 1812. with evidence
that the same has been duly located
upon the North East quarter of Section thirty
three, in township nine north, of Range four-
teen West, in the district of lands subject
to sale at Grand Island Nebraska contain-
ing one hundred and sixty acres. according
to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said
land returned to the General Land Office
by the Surveyor General the said warrant
having been duly assigned to Elizabeth Baker
in whose favor said tract has been located
Now know ye, That there is, therefore, granted
by the United States unto the said Elizabeth
Baker as assignee as aforesaid and to her
heirs the tract of land above described: To
have and to hold the said tract of land with
the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Elizabeth
Baker as assignee as aforesaid and to her
