To all to whom these presents shall come. Having  
Certificate No 2929. = Thomas Barriar S. Bentley of Buffalo  
County, Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office  
of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land  
Office at Grand Island, Nebraska whereby it appears  
that full payment has been made by the said Barriar  
S. Bentley according to the provisions of the Act of Congress  
of the 22<sup>nd</sup> of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further  
provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplement-  
tal thereto for the East half of the South East quarter  
of Section Eight and the South West quarter of the South  
West quarter of Section Nine in Township Twelve North  
of Range Eighteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in  
Nebraska containing One Hundred and twenty acres accord-  
ing to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands re-  
turned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General  
which said tract has been purchased by the said Barriar  
S. Bentley. Now Know Ye that the United States of America  
in consideration of the premises and in conformity with  
the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided  
have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant  
unto the said Barriar S. Bentley and to his heirs the said  
tract above described to have and to hold the same together  
with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances  
of whatsoever nature thereto belonging unto the said Barriar  
S. Bentley and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony  
whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the United States  
of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and  
the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed  
Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twentieth  
day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and eighty nine and of the Independence of the United States  
the one hundred and nineteenth
