The United States of America to all to whom these presents shall come greeting. Whereas Joseph Black of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Joseph Black according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820¹⁸²⁰ entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the lots numbered five and six of section eleven and the north half of the north east quarter of section fourteen in township eight north of range sixteen west of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty nine acres and twenty hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Joseph Black. Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Joseph Black and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Joseph Black and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Chester A. Arthur President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the tenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and sixth.
