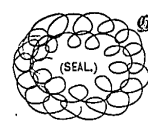
HOMESTEAD Certificate, No. 2015
APPLICATION 956
Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that, pursuant to the act of Congress, approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Mary Brady widow of William Brady deceased has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the North West quarter of Section twenty

four, in Township Nine North of Range fourteen West, in the district of lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska, containing one hundred and sixty acres,

according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Mary Brady the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Mary Brady and to her heirs and assigns forever.
