To all to whom the present shall come: Whereas there
has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a
Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska
whereby it appears that pursuant to the Acts of Congress approved
March 3, 1893, March 13, 1894 and June 14, 1898 "To encourage the growth of
timber on the Western Prairies" the claim of William M. Brook-
over has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law
for the South West Quarter of Section Four in Township Nine
North of Range Sixteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in
Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the
Official Plat of the survey of said land returned to the General Land Office by
the Surveyor General: Now know ye that there is therefore
granted by the United States unto the said William M. Brookover
the tract of land above described: To have and to hold the said tract
of land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said William M.
Brookover and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the United
States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal
of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
