The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 "To secure homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the act supplemental thereto, the claim of Alfred D. Brown has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law; for the North half of the North West quarter, the South East quarter of the North West quarter and the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section two in Township twelve North of Range six and West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty two acres and seventy six hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now know ye, that there is therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Alfred D. Brown the tract of land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Alfred D. Brown and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the city of Washington, the Twenty eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fourteenth.
