Homestead Certificate, no. 699. { To all whom these presents shall
Application 2353. } come, Greeting: Whereas, There
has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United
States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand
Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act
of Congress, approved 20th May 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to actual
settlers on the Public Domain"; as the acts supplemental thereto, the
claim of Dewitt Brown has been established & duly consummated,
in conformity to law, for the North East Quarter of section four, in
Township eight, north of Range seventeen, west, in the District of
Lands subject to sale at Grand Island, Nebraska, containing one
hundred & Fifty-nine acres & five hundredths of an acre, accord-
ing to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the
General Land Office by the Surveyor General. Now, know ye,
That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said
Dewitt Brown the tract of land above described: To have and to hold the
said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereto, unto the said
Dewitt Brown & to his heirs and assigns forever. In Testimony
whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United States of
America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the
General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
