The United States of America to all to whom these presents shall come greeting:  
Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Registrar of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20<sup>th</sup> May 1862. To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain and the able supplemental thereto the claim of George W. Brown has been established and duly examined in conformity to law for the West Half of the North West Quarter of Section Four in Township nine north of range Thirteen west in the District of lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing Eighty acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General. Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said George W. Brown the tract of land above described to have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereto unto the said George W. Brown and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Rutherford B. Hayes, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made public and the seal of the general land office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the Twenty fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred & second.
