The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:
Certificate No. 2056- Thomas Harvey Brown of Buffalo County
Nebraska has deposited in the General Land office of the United
States a Certificate of the Register of the Land office at Grand
Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has
been made by the said Harvey Brown, according to the provisions
of the Act of Congress of the 27th of April 1820 entitled "An
Act making further provision for the sale of the Public
lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the east half
of the north east quarter of section thirteen in Township
twelve north of Range fifteen west and the west half of the
north west quarter of section eighteen in Township twelve
north of Range eighteen west of the sixth Principal Meridian
in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty-two acres
and eighty nine hundredths of an acre, according to
the official plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned
to the General Land office by the surveyor General which
said tract has been purchased by the said Harvey Brown.
Now know ye, that the United States of America in consideration
of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress
in such case made and provided have given and granted and
by these presents do give and grant unto the said Harvey
Brown and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and
to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges,
immunities and appurtenances of what sort nature themunto
belonging unto the said Harvey Brown and to his heirs
and assigns for ever. In testimony whereof I Grover Cleveland
President of the United States of America have caused these letters
to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land office to be
hereunto affixed, Given under my hand at the City of
Washington the twenty first day of May in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty seven and of the
Independence of the United States the one hundred and eleventh.
