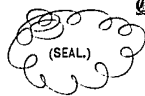
HOMESTEAD Certificate, No. 2087 APPLICATION 4603

Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that, pursuant to the act of Congress, approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Wright H. Brown has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the south half of the north East-quarter and the East half of the south East quarter of section Eighteen in Township Ten north of Range Seventeen west in the district of land subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Wright H. Brown the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Wright H. Brown and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I Rutherford B. Hayes President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

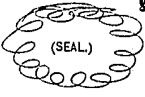
