Whereas John Buesing of Buffalo County Nebraska depos-  
ited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate  
of the register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears  
that full payment has been made by the said John Buesing  
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April  
1820 entitled "An act making further provision for the sale  
of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for  
the South half of the South East quarter of section seventeen in Township twelve  
North of Range seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska  
containing eighty acres, according to the Official Plan of the Survey of the  
said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said  
latter has been purchased by the said John Buesing. Now know ye I have the  
United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the  
several acts of congress in such case mad and provided have given  
and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John Buesing  
and to his heirs the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same to  
gether with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatso-  
ever nature thereunto belonging unto the said John Buesing and to his  
heirs and assigns forever. In Testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison  
President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be  
made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be here-  
unto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington  
the thirty first day of October in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight  
Hundred and Ninety and of the Independence of the United States the One  
hundred and Fifteenth,
