Certificate }  
No. 94. } Whereas, Andrew Buest of Hall County Nebraska ha deposited  
in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register  
of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that  
full payment has been made by the said Andrew Buest according to  
the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1820, entitled  
"An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for  
the South East Quarters of section Fourteen in Township Nine North of  
Range Thirteen west in the District of lands subject to sale at Grand  
Island Nebraska containing Eighty acres, according to the Official  
Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office  
by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the  
said Andrew Buest.

Now, Know ye, That the United States of America, in consider-  
ation of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress  
in such case made and provided, Have Given and Granted, and by these  
presents Do Give and Grant unto the said Andrew Buest and to his  
heirs, the said Tract above described; To have and to hold the same, to-  
gether with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of  
whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Andrew Buest  
and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I Ulysses S. Grant President of the United  
States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the  
Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the  
Eighth day of March, in the year of our Lord one  
thousand eight hundred and seventy two, and of  
the Independence of the United States the ninety  
sixth.
