Whereas Alexander C Carmichael of Buffalo County, Nebraska, has deposited in the General Land Office  
of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska, whereby it appears that  
full payment has been made by the said Alexander C Carmichael, according to the provisions of the act of Congress of

the 24th of April 1820, intituled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the lands East quarter of Section fourteen in Township twelve North of Range eighteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in Nebraska, containing 200 hundred and forty acres, according to the official Plat of the Survey of Land Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Alexander C. Carmichael.
