

The United States of America, To all to whom these presents shall come,
 Greeting: Certificate No. 641. Whereas D. Allen Crowell of Buffalo County, Nebraska has
 deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register
 of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full pay-
 ment has been made by the said D. Allen Crowell according to the provisions of
 the Act of Congress of the 21st of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further pro-
 vision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North half of the North West
 quarter of section eight, in Township eight North, of Range seventeen West, in
 the district of lands, subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska, containing
 eighty acres, according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said lands, re-
 turned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract
 has been purchased by the said D. Allen Crowell.

Now, know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of
 the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such
 case made and provided, Have given and granted, and by these presents do
 give and grant, unto the said D. Allen Crowell and to his heirs, the said
 tract above described; To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the
 rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, ther-
 unto belonging, unto the said D. Allen Crowell and to his heirs and assigns
 forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, President of
 the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and
 the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

 second day of June, in the year of our Lord one thou-
 sand eight hundred and seventy three, and of the
 Independence of the United States the Ninety seventh.
