 in the General Land Office of the United States
 a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at
 Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that
 Full Payment has been made by the said Drury L
 Cutter according to the provisions of the act of Congress
 of the 24th of April ¹⁸⁷⁰ entitled An Act making further
 provision for the sale of the Public Lands for the
 west half of the south east quarter of section twenty
 two in Township nine north of Range Fifteen
 in the eastern of Land & subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska
 west, containing Eighty acres according to the
 official Plat of the survey of the said Lands returned
 to the General Land Office by the surveyor General which
 said Tract has been purchased by the said Drury
 L Cutter now know ye That the United States of
 America in consideration of the promise and in
 conformity with the several acts of Congress in such
 case made and provided have given and granted
 and by these presents do give and grant unto
 the said Drury L Cutter and to his heirs and assigns
 forever In Testimony whereof Ulysses S Grant
 President of the United States of America have caused
 these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the
 General Land Office to be hereunto affixed

 the twenty fifth day of April in the year of our
 Lord one thousand Eight hundred and seventy
 four and of the Independence of the United States
 the twenty eighth
