To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting.

Certificate No. 1960.

Whereas John Campbell of Buffalo County, Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John Campbell according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 4th of April 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the public lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the Lots Five Six, Seven and Eight of Section Fourteen in Township Eight North of Range Fifteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing One Hundred and Nineteen acres and fifteen hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said John Campbell. Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John Campbell and to his heirs the said tract above described. To have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said John Campbell and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Chester A. Arthur President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the eleventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and ninth.
