So all to whom these presents shall come greeting;
Certificat No 3200. Whereas Alexander P. Cannon of Buffalo
County, Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office
of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land
Office at Grand Island, Nebraska whereby it appears that
full payment has been made by the said Alexander P.
Cannon according to the provisions of the act of Congress
of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further
provision for the sale of the Public lands" and the acts supplement-
ary thereto for the North East quarter of Section Twenty eight
in Township seven North of Range fourteen West of the
Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one
hundred and sixty acres, according to the official plat of the
survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by
the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by
the said Alexander P. Cannon, now known by the United States
of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity
with the several acts of Congress in such case made and pro-
vided have given and granted and by these presents do give and
grant unto the said Alexander P. Cannon and to his heirs the
said tract above described, to have and to hold the same together
with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances
of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Alexander
P. Cannon and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the
United States of America have caused these letters to be made
Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed
Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twentieth
day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and eighty nine and of the Independence of the United States
the one hundred and fourteenth.
