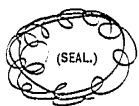

North West quarter of section fourteen in Township Eleven North of Range fifteen West of the sixth principal meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

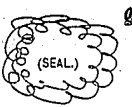

and the north half of the north west quarter of section thirty in Township Eleven north of Range thirteen west of the 6th principal meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty seven acres and twenty eight hundredths of an acre
