Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office, of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office, at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20<sup>th</sup> May 1862, to secure Homestead to actual settlers on the Public Domain, and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Benjamin C. Chapman has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the North East quarter of Section eighteen in Township Ten North of Range Thirteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in Nebraska, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General. Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Benjamin C. Chapman, his tract of land, above described to have, and to hold, the said tract of land, with the appurtenances therof, unto the said Benjamin C. Chapman, and to his heirs, and assigns forever.
