The United States of America. To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Certificate No. 598 Whereas Edwin Christianson in Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the general land office of the United States a certificate of the register of the land office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Edwin Christianson according to the provisions of the act of congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1820 entitled "an act making further provision for the sale of the public lands" for the North half of the North West quarter of section four in Township eight North of range Seventeen West in the district of lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing Seventy-nine acres and forty-one hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the general land office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Edwin Christianson. Now know ye that the United States of America in compliance of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such cases made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Edwin Christianson and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges and immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Edwin Christianson and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Ulysses S. Grant President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the general land office to be hereunto affixed, Given under my hand at the City of Washington the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Seventy-three and of the independence of the United States the Ninety seventh.
