Whereas John Christ Christensen of Buffalo County Nebraska  
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a  
certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska,  
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by  
the said John Christ Christensen according to the provisions of  
the Act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1820 entitled "An act making  
further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts  
supplemental thereto for the lot numbered Three of Section  
Seventeen in Township Eight North of Range Fifteen West  
of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing  
Twenty acres and Thirty hundredths of an acre according to  
the Official Plot of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the  
General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said  
tract has been purchased by the said John Christ Christensen.  
Now know ye, That the United States of America in consider-  
ation of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts  
of Congress in such case made and provided have given  
and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said  
John Christ Christensen and to his heirs the said  
tract above described: To have and to hold the same  
together with all the rights privileges immunities and appur-  
tenances of whatsoever nature thereto belonging unto the said  
John Christ Christensen and to his heirs and assigns forever.

United States of America have caused these letters to be made  
Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto  
affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the  
twelfth day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand

United States the One hundred and Fifteenth
