To all to whom these Presents shall come greeting, whereas John Clarke of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John Clarke according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled an act making further Provisions for the sale of the Public Lands; and the acts supplemental thereto for the late numbers one and two and the south east quarter of the north West quarter and the south West quarter of the north east quarter of section eighteen in Township Twelve North of Range seventeen West of the sixth Principle Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty five acres and forty four hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said John Clarke Now Know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these Presents do give and grant unto said John Clarke and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said John Clarke and to his heirs and assigns forever.
