To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:
Whereas Charles Cook Senior of Buffalo County Nebraska
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States
a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island
Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made
by the said Charles Cook Senior according to the provisions
of the Act of Congress of the 21st of April 1820 entitled "An Act
relating further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and
the acts supplemental thereto for the North half of the North
East quarter and the North half of the North West
quarter of section twenty eight in Township twelve North of Range
seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska
containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the
official Plat of the Survey of the Lands returned to the General Land
Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased
by the said Charles Cook Senior. Now know ye that the United
States of America in consideration of the premises aforesaid
and provided have given and granted and by these presents
do give and grant unto the said Charles Cook Senior and
to his heirs the said tract above described. Do have and hold the
same together with all the right privileges immunities and
appurtenances of whatsoever nature therein belonging unto the
said Charles Cook Senior and to his heirs and assigns forever.
In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the United
States of America have caused these letters to be made
Public and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto
affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the
twenty eighth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and ninety and of the Independence of the
United States the one hundred and fiftieth
