Homestead Certificate No. 11874 of all to whom these presents shall come greeting.
Application 7301
Whereas there has been deposited in the
General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the
Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant
to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 "To secure homesteads to actual
settlers on the Public Domain" and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of
Sophia Coombs formerly Sophia Holbrook has been established and
duly consummated in conformity to law for the North East Quarter of
Section fourteen in township eight north of range fourteen west of
the fifth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty nine
acres and twenty hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the
survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor
General. Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the United
States unto the said Sophia Coombs the tract of land above described
to have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof unto
the said Sophia Coombs and to her heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof I Chester A. Arthur President of the United
States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the
General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of
Washington the first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and eighty three and of the Independence of the United States
the one hundred and eighth.
