approved 20th May, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of

Sylvester St. John has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the lot numbered eleven of Section six in Township eight North of Range fourteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing six acres and forty hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Sylvester St. John the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Sylvester St. John and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Theodore Roosevelt, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the thirty first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty second.
