No. 715 Whereas John Saul of Buffalo County Nebraska has
deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate
of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island whereby it appears
that full payment has been made by the said John Saul
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2dnd of April
1820 entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public
Lands for the lots numbered five, six, seven and eight of Section four in
Township eight North of Range eighteen West in the District of Lands
subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing one hundred and
forty seven acres and thirty hundredths of an acre according to the
Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General
Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been
purchased by the said John Saul. Now know ye, That the
United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in
conformity with the several Act of Congress in such case made and
provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant
unto the said John Saul and to his heirs the said tract above described
to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges,
immunities and appurtenances of whatsoe'er nature thereunto
belonging unto the said John Saul and to his heirs and assigns forever.

United States of America have caused these letters to be made
Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed
Given under my hand at the City of Washington the fifth day
of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and twenty four and of the Independence of the United States the
